- 1909 Founded as Stabler & Baker LTD.
 Begins to manufacture industrial strip charts
- 1957 Graphic Controls incorporated in New York combining three chart companies:
 - The Selling Agent Company
 - Clarkson Press
 - Amherst Printing Company
- 1960s Entered the medical chart market
 Publicly listed
- 1970s Extended medical product line to include complementary products - E.G. Electrodes
- 1987-
1996 Acquired
 - Gubelman Charts
 - Plexicraft
 - Tronomed Medical
 - Upbeat Medical
 - Devon Medical
- 1998 Acquired by Tyco International - Medical business split to Tyco Healthcare
- 2000 Construction began on custom-designed \$20 million state-of-the-art global manufacturing environment
 - Acquired
 - Autron
 - Calibrated Charts
- 2001 Extended product offering to include gaming and entertainment tickets
- 2002 Integrated into Tyco's fire and safety group
 - Rationalized POS product line to focus on higher value security enabled POS products
- 2003 Acquired paper chart assets of Foxboro's chart production
- 2004 Graphic Controls is acquired by an entity formed by the principals of SIHI and Management
- 2006 Acquired
 - Charts, Inc.
 - Chart Specialties
- 2007 Acquired
 - Crown Graphics
